- Association with First Nations and Métis communities, kinship and organizations
- Demonstrated ability to work well within a team as well as independently
- Commitment to the principles of Catholic Education
- Preference will be extended to graduates of ITEP, SUNTEP, First Nations University of Canada and other Indigenous teacher education programs
