ABI Community Support provides support services to adults with an Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) to help them achieve their personal goals. The ABI Community Support Supervisor supervises a team of Community Support Workers (CSWs) who: (1) help clients pursue meaningful activities in the community, and (2) will promote the personal & social rehabilitation of adults with an ABI.

- Participant screening & admissions
- Participating in developing & implementing rehabilitation plans for clients, and matching clients with an appropriate Support Worker
- Linking individuals with an ABI with opportunities for personal & social rehabilitation
- Assisting with developing project proposals to increase opportunities for clients
- Supervising ABI community support workers
- Program promotion
- Reporting on the program to SaskAbilities and both the ABI Outreach Team in Saskatoon and the provincial ABI Partnership Program (Saskatchewan Health), as required

- Two to three years direct experience working in the Human Services Field experience working with individuals experiencing disability would be preferred
