Further to the recent update from the Ministry of Health and Saskatchewan Health Authority, FNUniv will adhere to all new preventative measures. Effective March 12th, all non-essential events, both internal and external, not directly tied to the academic progress of students, are cancelled until April 30, 2020. This will be re-evaluated in the future.

All tours (groups, schools) will be cancelled and/or rescheduled to a later date.

All organizers of any third-party events will be contacted to either postpone or cancel events until further notice.

FNUniv apologizes in advance as we recognize the time and effort that goes into planning an event of any size. The health and well-being of all students, faculty and staff is our foremost concern during this critical time.

Please continue to practice the following safe social distancing and proper hygiene precautions:

- wash hands often and for at least 20 seconds;
- cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze with a tissue or the bend of your elbow;
- avoid touching your mouth, nose or eyes with unwashed hands.
- practice social distancing by avoiding shaking hands or hugging and keeping your distance from anyone who is ill;
