### **LIBRARY UPDATE**

As of Friday March 20<sup>th</sup>, end of day (4 pm), our libraries will be closed until further notice; however, all Librarians will be working remotely, utilizing Lifesize virtual rooms to complete reference inquiries. If you need a class tutorial on accessing online information, we can accommodate. Please contact your campus library team member.

Several book publishers have changed their eBook models, from a single user to an unlimited user for those books we have purchased. Timeframes are now extended until the end of July 2020, with some exceptions.

For Regina, students will still have access to computers at Archer Library, as of March 19<sup>th</sup>. The library building is open Monday – Friday 8 am – 8 pm, and print material can be borrowed through their self-serve kiosk.
