As part of this team, the Consultant provides division-wide leadership and program development for Indigenous language curriculum and pedagogies, professional development for Indigenous language teachers, and cultural leadership with a specific emphasis on the development of curricular support resources.

The Consultant, First Nations, Métis and Inuit Education, also supports the Professional Development School partnership with the Indian Teacher Education Program (ITEP) at the University of Saskatchewan. The role entails supporting ITEP teacher candidates and instructing students in their pre-internship coursework.
