To Indigenous Social Work (INSW) Students,

The COVID-19 situation has placed considerable stress on the operations of the First Nations University of Canada. Management seeks to ensure that all staff and students are safe. Because of this new reality, our focus has been on ensuring the health and wellness of all employees, students and visitors. However, in order to minimize the impact on student's ability to complete their programs, we have had to examine how programs/courses need to be modified. Therefore, FNUniv Indigenous Social Work faculty have agreed to develop a one-time course offering of INSW 352. Only students that require this course in order to complete their program by the end of the Winter 2021 semester will be eligible to register.

INSW 352 will be offered in a manner that allows FNUniv to deliver the course in accordance with the directives from the provincial government, *i.e. mandatory social distancing.* The Faculty of Indigenous Social Work, in consultation with FNUniv Elders, has agreed to make this exception given the current circumstances.

Students who are eligible to take this revised course in July and August, will receive an email. Please register as soon as possible. If you are already registered than you do not need to take any action.


