

# LAPTOP LOAN PROGRAM

The First Nations University of Canada (FNUniv) will continue to offer the Laptop Loan Program for the Fall Term. Through sponsorship from SaskPower, FNUniv was able to purchase 57 laptops for our three (3) campus locations.

The Loan Program was created as an additional support for students facing the technological challenges encountered during the post-secondary transition to remote learning distance delivery.

FNUniv management supports the continued academic advancement of our students. We hope that the provision of such program will ease part of the hardship students may encounter over the next term.

## Eligibility:

• Must be a full-time FNUniv Student at any one of our campus locations.
