

Masking Update for Spring Summer Term

June 1, 2022

To all FNUUniv faculty, staff, and students,

Since the beginning of the Spring Summer Term, FNUUniv has maintained an **indoor masking requirement** in specific public spaces on each campus, in effect until May 31.

Effective June 1, 2022, indoor masking is no longer required in any campus location. However, for any members of the FNUUniv community who feel more comfortable with the safety and protection of wearing a mask, we continue to encourage and welcome masking while on campus. A supply of masks are available on all campuses.

We ask that you continue to be conscious of others' health and well-being. If you do not feel well or have tested positive for COVID-19, please stay home and advise the [FNUUniv Crisis Response Team](#) immediately.

We saw more flexibility with in-person activities and student engagement opportunities throughout this term, and the University will continue to monitor the situation and re-evaluate our safety measures as needed throughout the summer.
