**To All First Nations University of Canada Students,**

First Nations University of Canada will suspend classes and labs (both face-to-face and current online courses) next week to support a transition to distance learning for students. The suspension will also aid in reducing the possible spread of COVID-19.

**The suspension of classes will be for a minimum of 4 days, March 16<sup>th</sup> through to March 19<sup>th</sup>.**

Classes will resume, via distance learning distribution, on Friday, March 20<sup>th</sup>.

During this period, First Nations University of Canada faculty and instructors will prepare for the distance delivery of courses for the remainder of semester.

The method of delivery of final exams has yet to be determined. However, once a decision has been made, all students will be advised in advance.
